COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

Fitchburg State University 2023

- Inherited roster of 28 in January 2023 – recruited 41 student-athletes to get camp number to 69; 145% increase in roster size
- Going into the off-season with 54 on the roster – 92% increase from previous off-season
- Fundraised over \$15,000 between April 2023 and September 2023
- Increased team GPA from 2.17 in Spring 2023 to 2.77 in Fall 2023
- Most points scored and most yards gained since 2018
- Most passing touchdowns since 2017
- More 200 yard passing games than the previous 4 seasons combined
- Least amount of points and yards allowed since the 2018 season
- Most turnovers forced since 2017 season
- #9 ranked passing defense in the country (137.7 yards allowed per game)
- To date, we have over 75 individual campus visits (2024 class) without having a large scale prospect event this winter yet
- To date, we have 10 commits with 5 deposits (2024 class)

Elmhurst University 2022

- In previous 40 games before arrival, Elmhurst offense had 2 games of 350 total yards, we had 2 this year – the last time Elmhurst offense had 2 in 1 season was 2016
- In previous 40 games before arrival, Elmhurst offense had 5 games of 200 yards passing, we had 5 this year – the last time Elmhurst offense had 4 in 1 season was 2014
